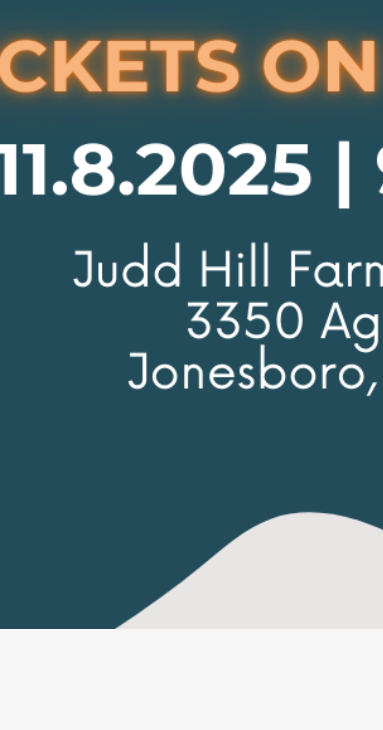

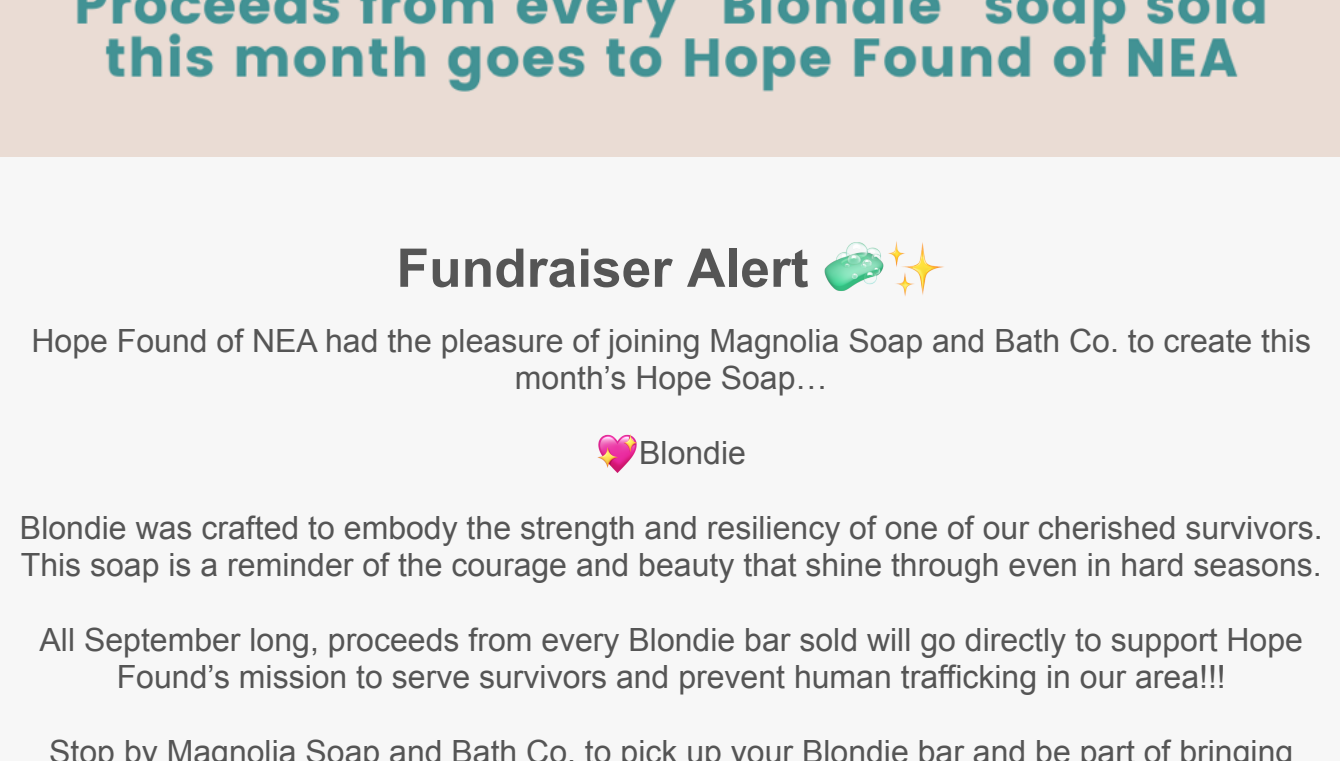

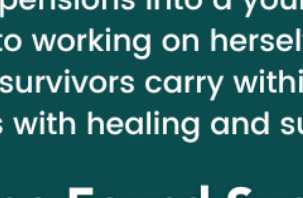
Hope Found of NEA is excited to welcome two incredible interns, Melanie Cox and Heaven Ferguson, from Arkansas State University! ❤️❤️
