We're celebrating five years of bringing HOPE to NEA in the fight to END human trafficking. In honor of our 5th Anniversary, we're asking you to give \$5.

We want to let you know just what \$5 - when multiplied by the strength of a community - can do.

•If **FIVE** people give just \$5, a survivor's personal hygiene supplies are bought for 1 month.

•If **TEN** people give just \$5, a minor can receive exploitation prevention education.

•If **TWENTY** people give just \$5, a survivor's emergency housing needs are met for 1 night.

•If **FIFTY** people give just \$5, a survivor's aftercare support for 1 week is covered.

•If **ONE HUNDRED** people give just \$5, a survivor's therapy for 1 month is covered.

•If **TWO HUNDRED** people give just \$5, a survivor's aftercare support for 1 month is covered.






## **Volunteer Highlight**

We continue to bring HOPE and work towards ENDING human trafficking. Here is the impact our supporters, volunteers, and donors helped us make in March:

•Minors served: 15 •Adults served: 5

\*Services provided: Weekly/Monthly check-ins facilitating the iEmpathize Curriculum, Cool Aunt Series, and the Radiant Bible Study; providing individual advocacy, transportation assistance, hotline crisis and individual crisis intervention, emergency financial and housing assistance, legal and criminal justice assistance, and referrals to other victim services programs.

•Five minors completed the iEmpathize exploitation prevention curriculum this past month.

• We participated in the ASU Community Outreach Event.

•Thirty-one adult professionals attended our human trafficking 101 presentation.
